SLOC is proud to announce the final show of our 82nd season, The Scarlet Pimpernel. An area premiere, this show has been a critical and audience favorite since its debut on Broadway in 1997, garnering multiple awards and accolades. The Scarlet Pimpernel, the world renown novel, written by Baroness Orczy, and the show are set in England and France during the Reign of Terror of The French Revolution. With stirring music by Frank Wildhorn, and enthralling book and lyrics by Nan Knighton, this exquisite tale of a man with a secret identity who longs to save his country and the one he loves from harm, has something for everyone.

Playing the title character is Shawn Morgan, with Heather D'Arcy as Marquerite St. Just, Eric Shovah as Chauvelin, and Matthew Streifert as Armand St. Just. ## Board Members for the 2009-2010 Season



A member qualifying as a voting member shall be entitled to personally request one (1) absentee ballot from the Secretary. The request
