

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A Letter From The Director

"Once upon a time, there was a little ogre named Shrek, who lived with his parents in a bog by a tree..." And thus begins the story of Shrek, the large, green, cranky, but hopelessly lovable character, created by American author William Steig, and made famous in the series of films by DreamWorks Animation, beginning in 2001.

Well into my adult life when the films were first released, I, like so many other "mature" audience members, was immediately drawn in and became an instant fan. The writing is hysterical, the characters are well



developed, and the soundtracks are upbeat and catchy. I think what is most attractive about the films, particularly the first, is that its theme centers around self-perception and taking pride in oneself and whatever "group(s)" that you may belong to. In this particular fairy tale, our hero is an ugly, ill-tempered ogre. Our princess is also not all that she appears to be. In fact, all of the characters have something unique about them that make them different. What makes *Shrek* an exceptionally special film is the experience of watching each character learn to love their unique self and discover that, as Shrek states, "beautiful ain't always pretty." What an incredible message!

Like the ogre himself, the musical adaptation of *Shrek* is BIG, and bringing it to life onstage is no simple feat. What you will see tonight is the result of endless hours of collaboration, with many volunteers bringing their unique talents to the project. From the bottom of my heart, I'd like to thank each and every person on my production team, as well as all of the parents and other folks who painted flats, sewed costumes and moved scenery. You are simply amazing!

And what is a show without a cast? I'd like to tell you a little bit about the young performers that you will be seeing on the stage tonight. As you will find out in a moment, each one is incredibly talented. INCREDIBLY TALENTED! Much more than that, they are simply amazing human beings. Smart. Caring. Empathetic. Did I say SMART? In preparation for the show, we did a lot of work with character development, scene study, plot analysis, etc. One particular rehearsal, we had a lengthy discussion regarding the message of the show. Many actors contributed stories about what it's like to be different, some giving personal stories. They also offered specific examples of what's really happening in the world today and how equality is something that should not only be hoped for, but should be a given. That was my favorite of all of the rehearsals. It was on that night that I realized that this world is in good hands with this generation. They get it. They understand the need to be compassionate and to see people for who they are, not what society wants them to be.

With that said, please sit back and enjoy Jeanine Tesori and David Lindsay-Abaire's musical adaptation of *Shrek*. My hope is that you leave the theater, not only entertained, but moved by the message of the characters and the young folks that play them.

And, if the mood hits you... Let Your Freak Flag Fly!




