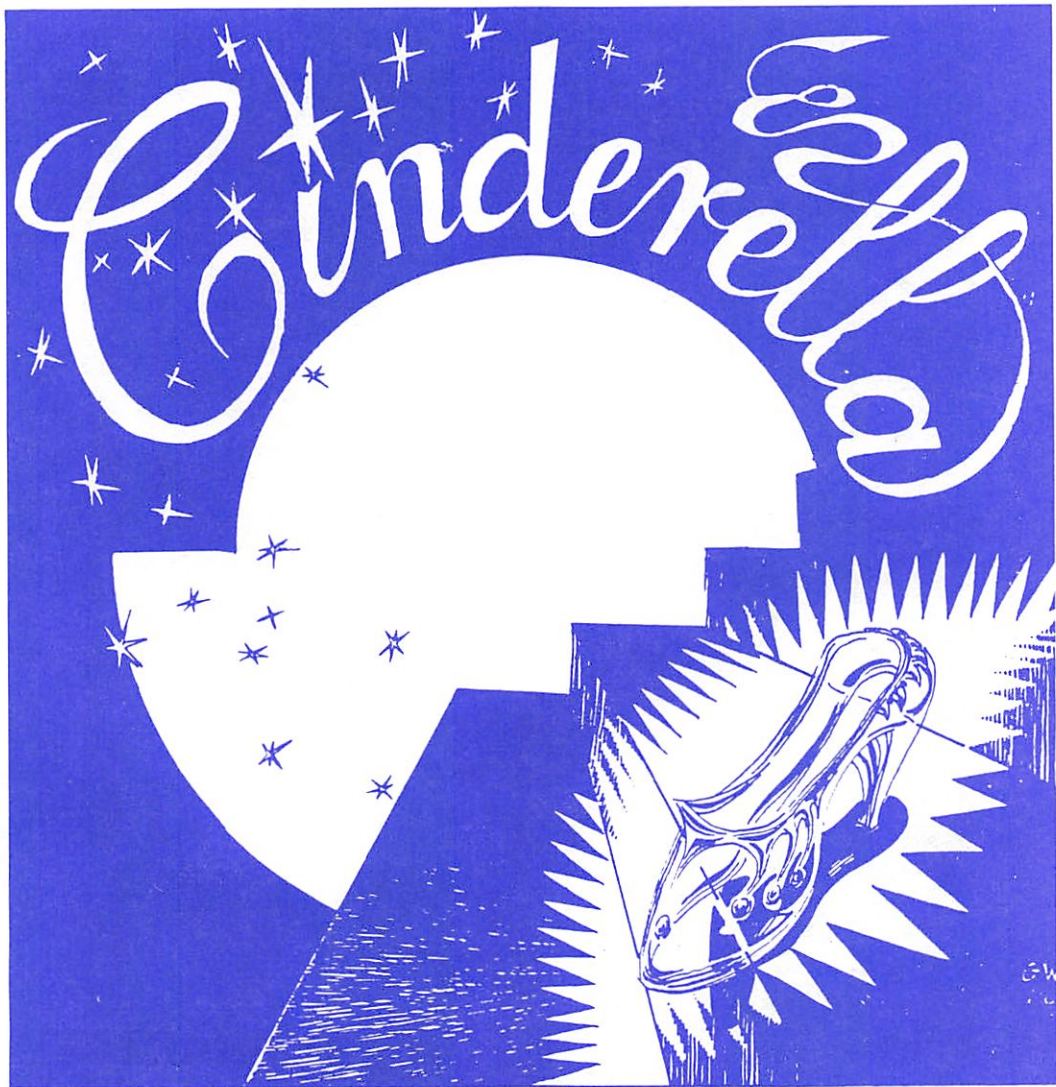

DAVID LOUIS * (*Prince*) played Billy Crocker in *Anything Goes*. He is a graduate of SUNY Albany and is now with the Division of Quality Assurance -- NYS Office of Mental Retardation.

GWEN ELLEN FRASER (*Godmother*) has been a featured player in countless SLOC productions, including *Carousel*, *Guys and Dolls*, *Robber Bridegroom*, *Grease*, *Oliver*, *Damn Yankees* and *No No Nanette*, and has served on the Board. In addition, she has been director, musical director and lead player in most area theater groups. Gwen is Music/Theater Teacher at Troy HS.

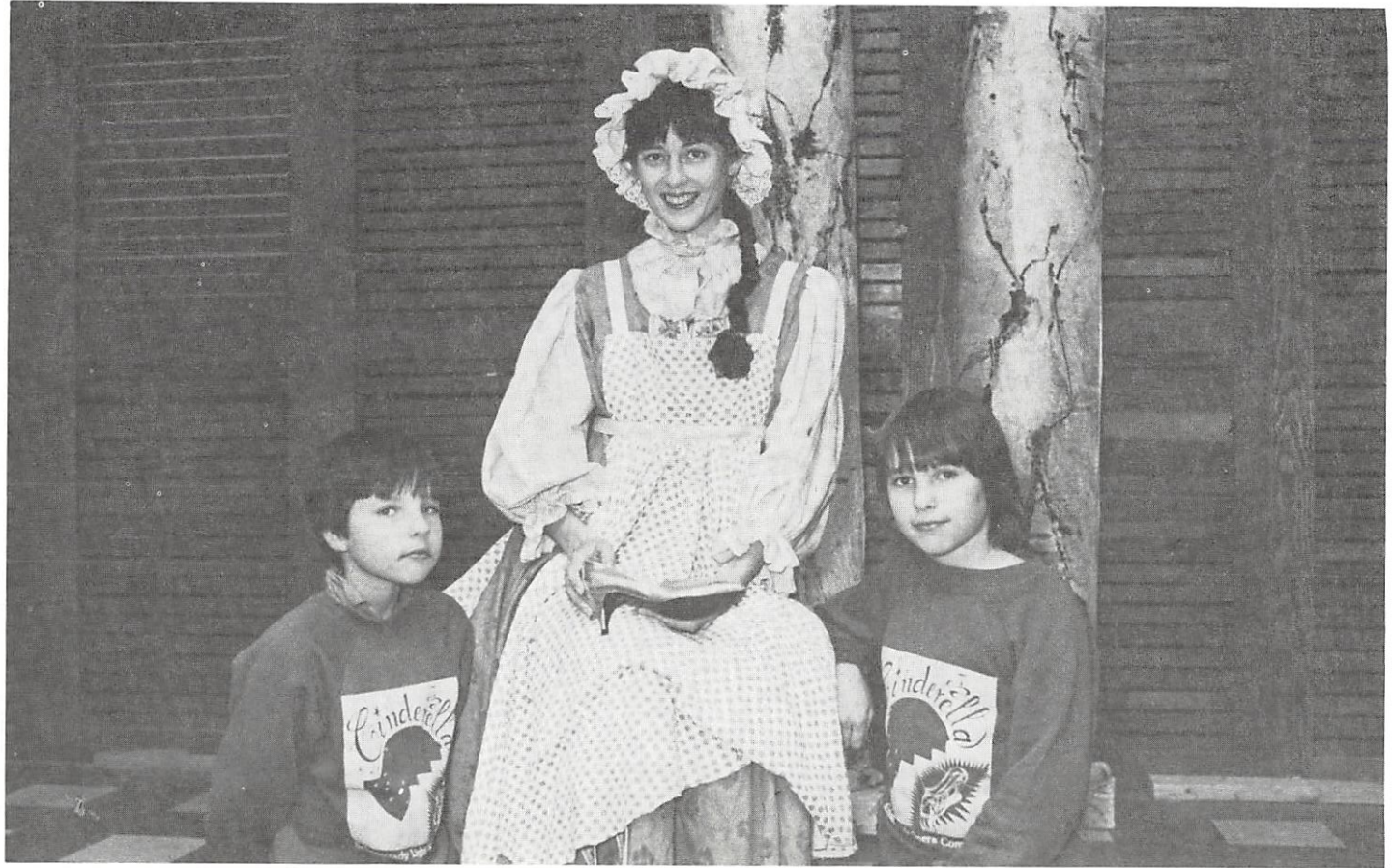

Who's Who in Production

GIOIA OTTAVIANO (*Producer*) has been SLOC president twice, secretary, a vice president, producer countless times and has served on "committees galore". She also serves as frequent producer and committee member for Civic Playhouse. She has seen most plays on, off, and off-off Broadway in recent years, and has been in the audience in Africa, China, South America, and many other places during her numerous trips abroad. Gioia is a teacher-librarian at Lincoln School, Schenectady.

MATTHEW G. MOROSS (*Director*) was in SLOC's *George M*, *Brigadoon*, *Carousel* and *The Boy Friend*, and worked backstage on *Man of LaMancha*, *Guys and Dolls*, *Carnival*, and others. He was a founder of The Second Stage and has appeared onstage at the Williamstown Theatre Festival, Albany Civic Theatre and RPI. Matt is a former Board member, vice-president and president of The Schenectady Civic Playhouse and will direct "*Painting Churches*" for them in April.

DUNCAN MORRISON (*Director*) appeared in *Shenandoah* and *Oliver* and was Assistant Director for *Grease* and *Pippin* for SLOC and for *1776* at the Palace. He served as director, producer and actor for Second Stage Productions, director for Civic Playhouse and was set designer for several Albany Civic Theatre productions. Duncan is employed by Adirondack Scenic, Inc.

VINCENT M. BONAFEDE (*Musical Director*) serves in this capacity for the tenth time, most recently for *Barnum*, *Wizard of Oz*, and *Hello Dolly*. A graduate of SUC Fredonia and SUC Potsdam (Masters in music composition), Vince is music teacher and director of musical productions at Hoosic Valley Schools. In his spare time he is organist/choral director at Lynwood Reformed Church and composes sacred vocal music.

HELENA BINDER BRESS (*Choreographer*) Helena dedicates the dances in *Cinderella* to the memory of her dear friend, Caren McGee-Russell, and thanks the cast for their enthusiastic spirit and dedication.

ELEANOR STRACK (*Assistant Director*) taught English and Theater workshop classes at Burnt Hills/Ballston Lake HS and directed several of their productions, including *Sound of Music*. She directed five productions for Pashley Players, one of which was *Cinderella*. She also was assistant-director of *She Stoops to Conquer* at Schenectady Civic Playhouse.
