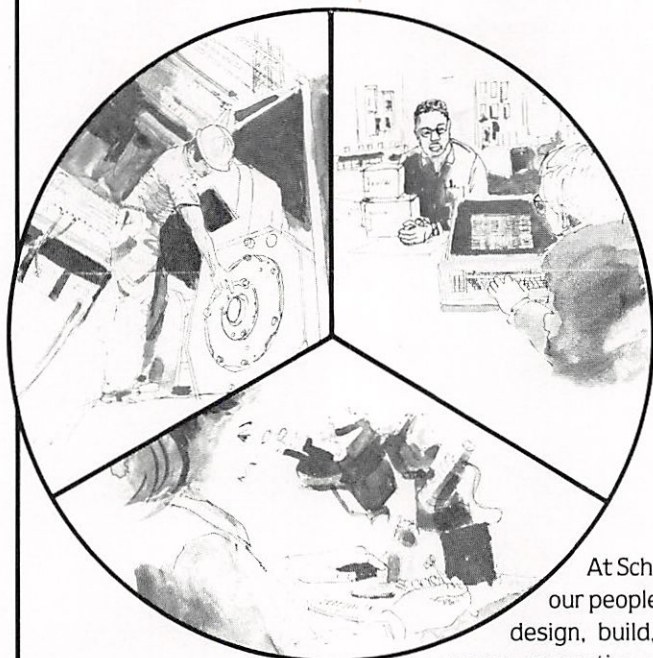

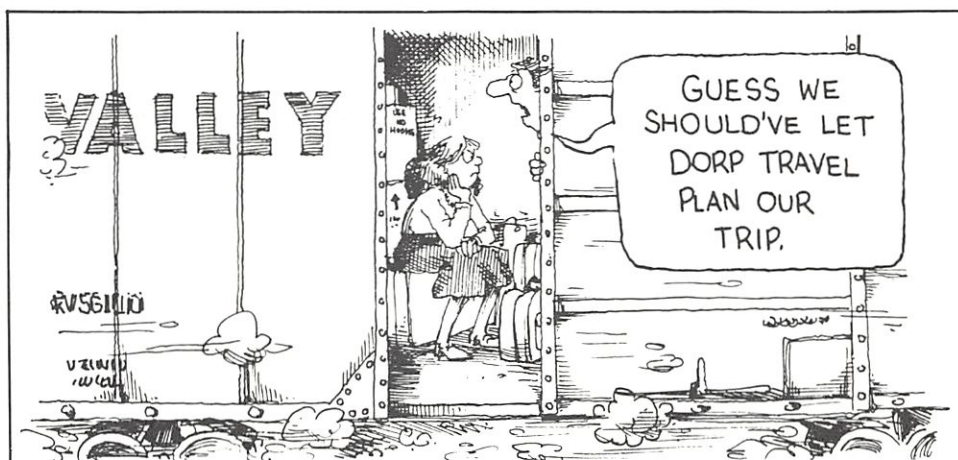



Who's Who in the Cast

WILLIAM D. HATCH (*Harold Hill*) is playing his fourth role in a SLOC show, having been seen as *Curly* in *Oklahoma*, *James* in *Shenandoah*, and *Billy Bigelow* in *Carousel*. With other theater groups he has had principal roles in *1776*, *I Do, I Do!* and *Fiddler on the Roof*. Bill received a B.A. in Economics from Brigham Young University, and is Merchandise Assistant-Automotive Buyer for Sears.

CAROLEE CARMELLO (*Marian*) graces the SLOC stage for the first time. She had leading roles with area groups in *Fiddler on the Roof*, *Sound of Music*, *Oliver*, and has done TV and radio commercials. Carolee sings with the University Chorale at SUNY Albany where she will receive a B.S. in Business Administration this spring.

George has also appeared with Schenectady Civic, Slingerlands Players, and the Cooperstown Summer Playhouse. He is Rector of St. Matthews Episcopal Church, Latham.

JANE COFFEY (*Eulalie Shinn*) first became active with SLOC 35 years ago. Her many shows include the 1971 *Oliver*, *Mame*, *How To Succeed*, and *Chocolate Soldier*. She has also been assistant director and served on numerous committees. Jane founded the Pashley Players, is Musical Director of the Charlton Heights Little People's Theater, and a retired music teacher, Burnt Hills-Ballston Lake Schools.

SCOTT WILLIAM FIELDS (*Marcellus*) is appearing in his first SLOC production. However, he has had extensive experience, including 27 shows with the Salt City Playhouse, Syracuse and roles with the Galway Players and Adirondack Players. His shows include *Li'l Abner*, *Odd Couple*, *Brigadoon* and *Man of La Mancha*.

CHRISTOPHER ALAN DICK (*Winthrop*) is a newcomer to SLOC, but appeared as young George in *George M*, *Winthrop* in *Music Man*, and one of the children in *The King and I*, for the Mac Hayden Theatre. Chris is from Kinderhook and a sixth grade student.
