## Who's Who in the Cast

**TED FARRELL** (*Henry Higgins*) has been involved in many SLOC activities, both on and off stage. He was Set Construction Co-Chairman for last season's *Hello Dolly*. For Civic Playhouse he has directed, served as business manager and acted in over a dozen shows. Ted is Manager of Systems Programming, Research Foundation for Mental Hygiene.

**JEAN JOHNSON FOSTER** (*Eliza*) will be remembered by SLOC audiences for her Laurie in *Oklahoma* and Polly Browne in *The Boyfriend*. She has been active in all aspects of Civic Playhouse, including roles in *Oh Coward* and *Ten Little Indians*. Jean is Director of Medical Records, Conifer Park Rehabilitation Center.

**PETER STEWART** (*Colonel Pickering*) was seen in last season's *1940's Radio Hour* and played Alfred P. Doolittle in SLOC's 1966 production of *My Fair Lady*. He has appeared in many shows at Civic Playhouse and acted and directed for theater groups in Canada and England. Peter is Consultant-Technical Relations at G.E. Research and Development Center.

**HOWARD G. MOYER** (*Alfred P. Doolittle*) is Assistant Director in addition to his on-stage appearance. Howard is a SLOC regular, having appeared as Judd Fry in *Oklahoma* and Bill Sykes in both productions of *Oliver*. He was assistant-director of *Sweet Charity* and *Hello Dolly* and will be directing the spring '86 production of *Little Mary Sunshine*. Howard teaches science at Central Park Junior High School, Schenectady.

**MOLLY WRIGHT** (*Mrs. Pearce*) also serves as Costume Mistress, a job she has held for many SLOC productions. She sang in the choruses of *Annie* and *Hello Dolly* and served as producer for *1776* and *Funny Girl*. A native of Blackpool in the north of England, Molly served in the British Army during World War II.

**DAVE CHARLES** (*Freddy*) played Bert Healy and Justice Brandeis in *Annie* and was recently seen as Vince Fontaine in *Grease* at Cohoes Music Hall. He was a Resident Company Member of Landmark Theatre, Syracuse, and has been M.C. for numerous professional acts at the Coliseum Theatre. Dave is broadcaster/promotion director for WABY/WWOM Radio.

**LOIS STILLEY** (*Mrs. Higgins*) appeared as Mme. Dubonnet in *The Boy Friend* for SLOC. At Civic Playhouse she played Rosemary in *Picnic* and the Mother in *Ring Around the Moon* and has had numerous roles at the Arena Stage in Washington, D.C. and other stock companies throughout the Northeast.

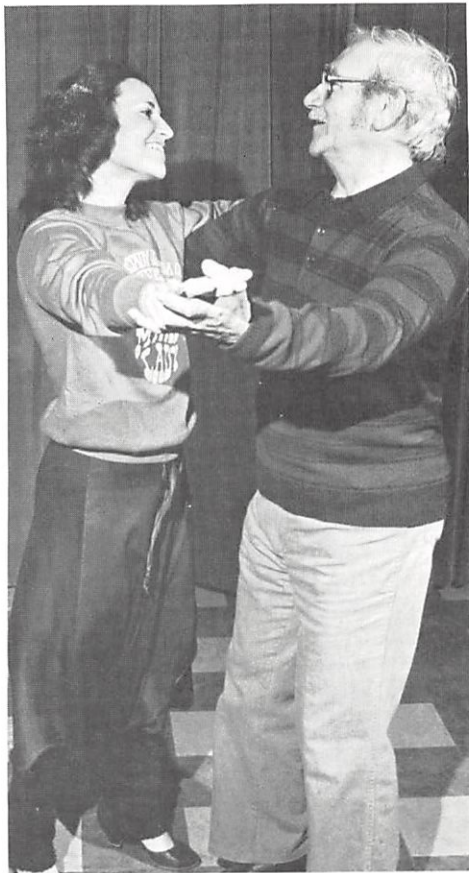

## Who's Who in Production

**PATRICIA THOMPSON** (*Producer*) is serving in this capacity for the first time but has held many roles onstage and off for SLOC. She played Mrs. Paroo in *Music Man* and directed *Bells Are Ringing* and appeared in *Grease*, *Robber Bridegroom* to name a few. At Civic Playhouse she has directed and worked in most technical areas and was recently seen as Steffie in *I Ought To Be in Pictures*. Pat is Chairman of the English Department of Draper Schools.

**CARMEN SGARLATA** (*Director*) has been featured in nearly two dozen shows during his association with SLOC, and has appeared with other theatre groups in the area including Civic Playhouse and TSU. 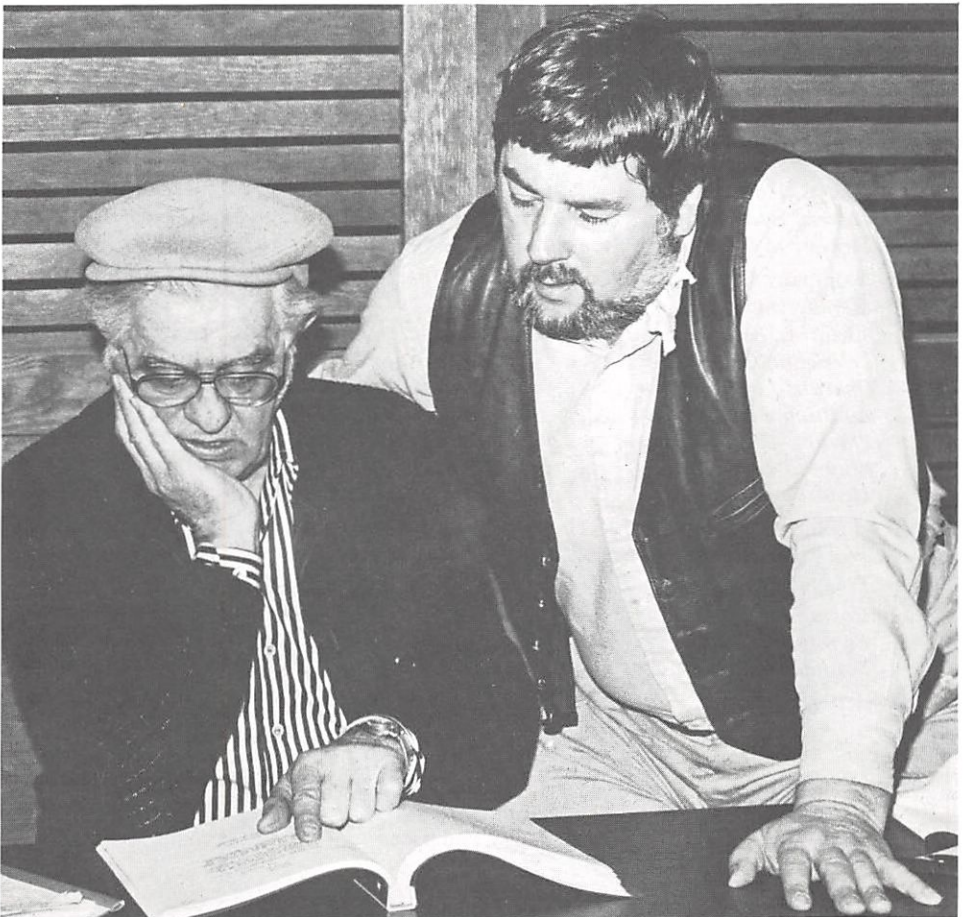
