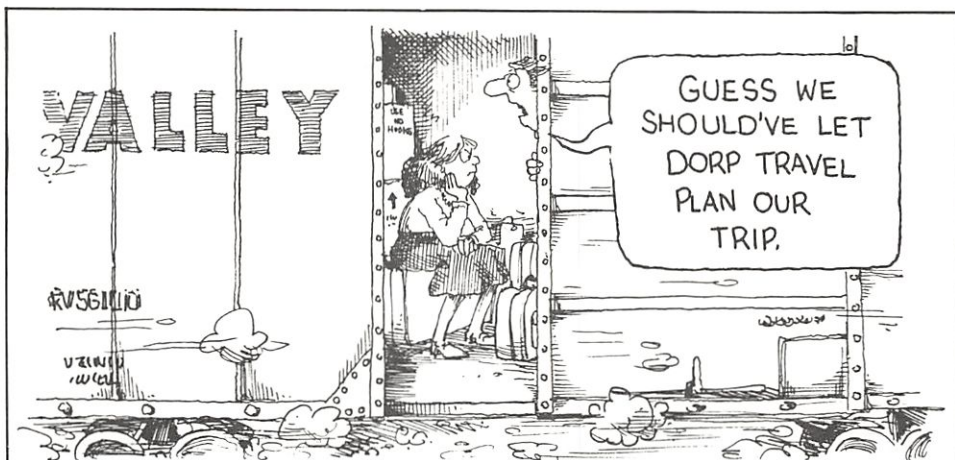





JOSEPH FAVA (*Alvin*) has directed nine SLOC productions including *Oliver*, *Grease*, *Shenandoah*, *Candide*, *1776*, and *Carnival*. He has appeared onstage in several SLOC productions and has directed for and appeared in productions of Schenectady Civic Players and Albany Civic Theatre. Joe is past president of Schenectady Civic and is on SLOC's Board. He is proprietor of Joseph's Hair Stylists.

JOHN ALLEN (*Wally*) was seen as Fagin in SLOC's *Oliver*, played Danny Zucko in *Grease*, Jamie in *Robber Bridegroom*, and Sam in *Shenandoah*. With other area groups he appeared in *Time of Your Life*, *Company*, *Brigadoon*, and *Hello Dolly*. John earned a B.A. in English at Boston College and is employed as a producer/writer by Albany Educational Television.

IRIS DAGOSTINO (*Cleo*) has had principal roles in numerous SLOC shows, including *Godspell*, *Grease*, *A Little Night Music*, *Company*, but is probably best remembered as Adelaide in *Guys and Dolls*. Iris graduated from SUC Oswego, and earned her Master in Library Science at SUNY Albany. She is head of Children's Services with the Bethlehem Public Library.

KAREN McGRATH (*Monica*) was seen as Nancy in *Oliver*, Marty in *Grease*, and Paquette in *Candide*. 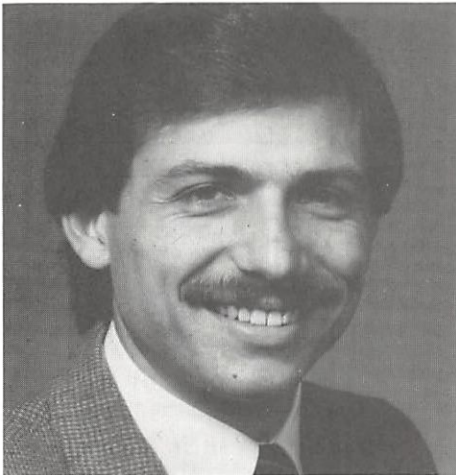

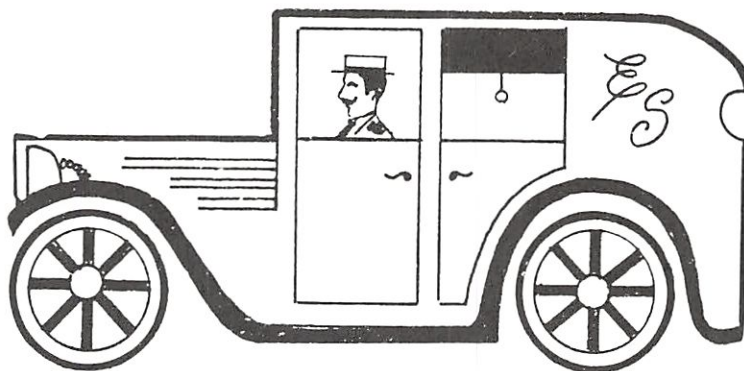

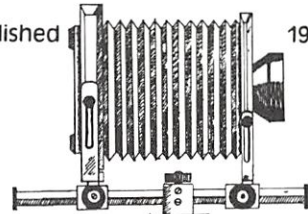
