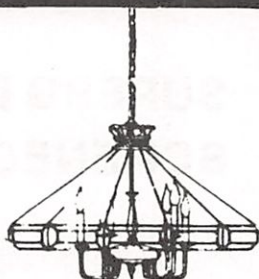

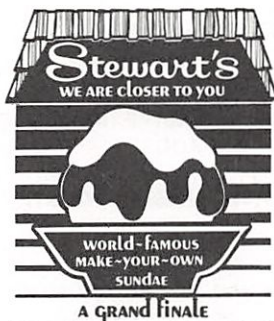

Who's Who in Production

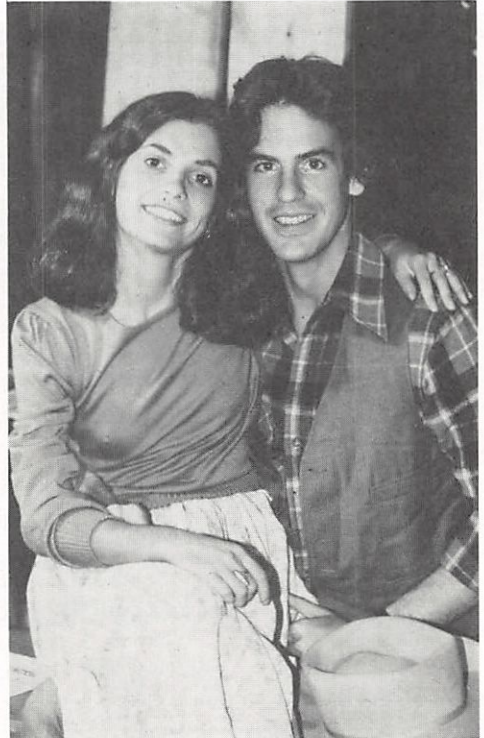
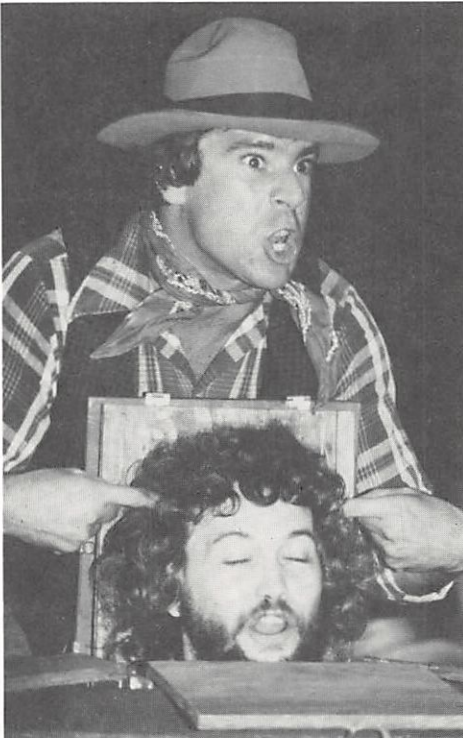
